

Meet Me In Capri FAQs

1. What is the date, time, and location of the event?

- a. Saturday, March 2nd, from 6 - 11pm at Round Hill Country Club. 3169 Roundhill Road, Alamo.

2. How much do tickets cost?

- a. Early Bird (January 16th - January 29th) = \$150 per person
- b. Late Bird = (January 30th - February 9th) = \$165 per person

3. What does the ticket price include?

- a. Welcome Drink, Hand Passed Appetizers, Salad, Entree, Dessert, Late Night Pizza, Raffles, Access to Live Auction, DJ, and Dancing!

4. What should I expect at the event?

- a. 6pm - 7pm Cocktail Hour with Hand Passed Appetizers
- b. 7pm - 9pm Dinner & Dessert and Live Auction
- c. 9pm - 11pm Dancing and Late Night Pizza

5. When can I buy tickets?

- a. Early Bird Ticket Sales go live on Tuesday, January 16th and will close at midnight on January 29th.
- b. Late Bird Ticket Sales begin on Tuesday, January 30th and end on February 9th at midnight.
- c. We ask that all tickets be purchased before February 9th so we have time to make seating assignments, create bid paddles and finalize meals with Round Hill. Any requests for tickets after February 9th will be subject to availability.

6. How do I buy tickets?

- b. Tickets will be available for purchase from January 16th until February 9th.

7. What is the menu?

- a. All guests will start with a plated Italian Greens Salad (fennel, toasted hazelnuts, roasted pear, and balsamic vinaigrette). There are three entree options for all attendees. You will be asked to select your entree choice when you purchase your ticket.

Option #1: Gluten Free Beef (grilled black angus bavette steak with yukon and artichoke hash, seasonal vegetables, roasted vidalia onions, and red wine demi glace) served with Tiramisu for dessert.

Option #2: Fish (Pan-Seared Petrale Sole with peperonata rustica, wild jasmine rice, beurre blanc) served with Tiramisu for dessert.

Option #3: Vegan (roasted portobello mushroom with roasted seasonal vegetables, organic farro, baby kale, and basil pesto) served with a trio of sorbet with berries for dessert.

8. Will dietary restrictions be accommodated?

- a. Yes! We have Gluten Free, Vegan, and Vegetarian options for the appetizers, salad, entrees, and dessert! The late night pizza will NOT be GF or Vegan.

9. Can I purchase tickets for other people?

- a. All attendees must purchase their own tickets for bidder number and accounting purposes. Please only purchase tickets for yourself and your date, if you are bringing one. If you would like to make a donation to contribute to a pool for staff tickets or become a sponsor of the event, there will be options to do so when you buy your individual tickets.

10. Can I purchase tickets at the door?

- a. All tickets must be purchased online in advance of the event. **This is required** to assign tables / bid numbers and create bid paddles in advance as well as for accounting purposes. In addition, we only provide meals for those who have bought tickets in advance. The LAST day to purchase tickets is February 9th.

11. Are tickets refundable?

- a. No. Tickets are not refundable and all payments are donations to the Alamo Ed Fund.

12. Can I transfer or sell my tickets to another person?

- a. There are many considerations when creating table arrangements and bid paddles, plus sensitive credit card information and waiver signing that take place during the ticket buying process. If for any reason you cannot attend and are letting someone else use your ticket, please let us know by Thursday, February 29th. **The new ticket holder will not have a choice in their seat selection, meal choice or be able to switch seats during the dinner service.** They will not receive a personalized bid paddle and you will have to work out payment for any auction items with them once the gala is over.

13. Who will I sit with at dinner?

- a. When purchasing your ticket you will have the option to list names of individuals who you would like to sit with OR you can request a grade level table. We will do our best to accommodate all requests!

14. What is the dress code?

- a. It may still be winter in Alamo, but our gala will transport you to the Amalfi Coast! Come dressed in your version of a chic Italian summer vacation on the Mediterranean! See our [pinterest](#) board for more inspiration.

15. How do I get to the event and/or park?

- a. We strongly encourage the use of a rideshare program, especially if you plan on consuming alcohol. Otherwise there is ample parking at Round Hill Country Club. You can either self-park or utilize the complimentary valet parking.

16. What live auction items will be available?

- a. A preview of some of the live auction items will be available on the auction website when you purchase your gala tickets. Many favorite items are back including: Principal for a Day, VIP Parking in the upper lot, a full set of braces from Majeroni, a Giants Field Experience, a vacation home in Newport Beach, and an All White Adult Party at the Soltani House!

17. How will the auction work?

- a. The live auction is very exciting! Our donations team has been diligently pulling together a variety of items that you don't want to miss! We will also have a dessert auction as part of the evening. We have a professional auctioneer to guide us through the action packed bidding process. The auction will occur during the dinner and dessert portion of the event.

18. Will there be alcohol available?

- a. Yes! There are a range of options for alcohol purchases:
 - NEW this year you can pre-purchase a bottle of wine for yourself, your table, or a teacher table! When you purchase your tickets you will see a range of wines with various price points to "add to your cart." All proceeds from these purchases will benefit the ed fund.
 - At the event you can visit the wine table where donated bottles of wine will be sold, and all proceeds will benefit the Alamo Ed Fund. The price of these bottles will range from \$40 - \$100.
 - Finally, Round Hill will also have a full bar, where alcohol can be purchased with credit card or member charges (all proceeds will go to Round Hill).

19. Are children allowed at the event?

- a. The event is for adults only. Please make other arrangements for your children for the evening. We would like to recommend the Danville Babysitters Club which is run by two San Ramon Valley High School Students. 20. Can I bid on an auction item if I do not attend?

- a. You can not bid on any live auction items, however we will also have a variety of items in our online auction from Monday, February 5th - Tuesday, February 13th.
